COMPUTER CLASSES

Computer 101- Start with the Basics

This class is excellent for beginners as it will provide basic instruction on the access and functionality of your computer software and hardware. Classes are 2 hour sessions from 1:00 – 3 PM, beginning Monday, March 19th 2018. Class duration (3) Weeks.

Basic Microsoft Word 2016

Basic Microsoft Excel 2016.

Intermediate Microsoft Word 2016

After you master the basics of using Microsoft ® Word 2016 such as creating, editing, and saving documents, navigating through a document, and printing, you're ready to move on to tackling the more advanced features. These features enable you to create complex professional documents with a consistent look and feel. They also enable you to automate (Mail Merge) tedious tasks such as preparing a letter to send to every customer of your organization. 2 hour each session, (3) Weeks classes beginning Tuesday April 10th, 17th, and 24th from 6-8 PM.

E-Mail

Beginners establishing E-Mail accounts. This is a must use tool necessary in today's society. Going fast are the days of "snail mail" This is a 2 hour class beginning Tuesday March 20th 2018, as well as Tuesday March 27 both starting at 5 PM -7 PM.
